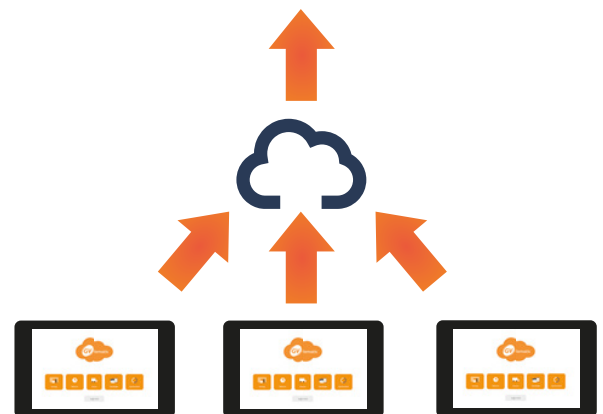
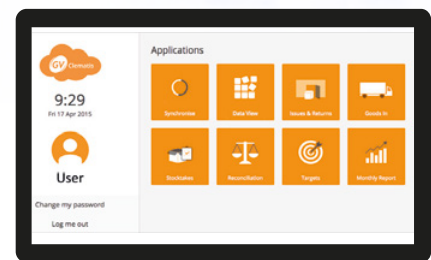
Clematis is specifically designed to track inventory and manage demand and usage of materials and resources. Clematis accurate data collection and cloud based storage provides accurate, up to date information and intelligence for organisations, by recording movement of goods and materials to manage demand and usage.

Resource management
 Improving efficiency & reducing waste

Clematis helps manage usage of any resource by keeping track of demand, whatever and wherever it is. If you can see the frequency and source of the demand for any item, you can ensure its availability and you can manage that demand effectively. This applies to any resource based activity that requires managing. Clematis is most commonly used to track products and manage their availability, but can equally be applied to labour in service and maintenance environments.

Multiple sites & locations

Clematis is a cloud based managed service, allowing multiple users in multiple locations to record product issues and report on where products are being used. Users can run comparisons between sites and hospitals, as well as drill down into the data to identify trends and solutions.

Clematis is cloud-based and data input usually takes place on a tablet, ipad or laptop so it is particularly suited for mobile data recording. Clematis is not expensive to install, not complicated to use and it is easy and quick to access and analyse the data.



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Monitoring Usage & cost

Clematis' accurate data collection provides up to date information and intelligence for organisations, by recording movement of goods and materials. Example; for healthcare providers, this can be all types of consumables, disposables, laundry and catering. Clematis also provides powerful analysis of distribution and allocation.

Healthcare & NHS

Used across Hospitals in a range of areas

- Domestic Stores – records all stores movement in and out to final destination; usage pattern analysis for users and products; stock checks; run rates for re-ordering and ensuring no shortages; bench-marking usage for control of over-use.
- Catering & Patient Meals – simple method of recording meals to each ward or department; patterns of ordering for planning purposes; easy month-end reporting for billing purposes.
- Linen Rooms – issue of linen; reporting against SLAs; monitoring of rewash; validation of charges.
- Laundry – recording of movements in and out of laundry to end destination; basis for charging.
- Waste Stream Management - monitoring of waste tonnage by stream from source.
